# HISTORIC SNAKE CREEK FARM & VILLAGE



## *Directions From Philadelphia*

1. Northeast extension of PA turnpike to end in Clarks Summit.
2. North on Interstate 81 to New Milford Exit 223.
3. Continue to Stop sign, make left on 492 for 1 mile.
4. At Stop sign, turn left on Rt. 11 for 1 mile.
5. Turn right on Rt. 706 toward Montrose, approximately 8 miles.
6. Turn right onto Rt. 29N for 1 mile, Snake Creek Farm will be on the right.

## *Direction from New Jersey / New York*

1. Interstate 80 west to Interstate 380 on Interstate 81 North.
2. Follow Directions 2 through 6 from above.

## *Directions from Update New York*

1. Rt. 84S to 17E to 81S towards Scranton, exit 1 Kirkwood/Conklin.
2. Turn right at Stop sign and follow to traffic light at Rt. 11.
3. Make left on Rt. 11, and continue to Rt. 7 toward Montrose.
4. Rt. 7 becomes Rt. 29, Snake Creek Farm on left, approximately 12 miles.
